### CONCERT SERIES IN THE 2020\_2021 ARTISTIC SEASON

#### BRILLANTE

[brilliantly, effectively]]

This series of concerts is distinguished by the openness and brilliance in approach of the music: across the genres of music this spectacular drawing explores the wealth and diversity of the world of music. The series includes well known pieces of music, as well as discovering sounds that in combination with the colours of the entire orchestra or of selected instruments and the energy of the outstanding performers, will appeal to a wide range of listeners.

#### ESPRESSIVO

[expressively]

These events will fill the Philharmonic space with what is truly expressive and unique. The series will present outstanding stars of Polish and international jazz scenes, and the listeners will encounter intense emotions expressed with lyrical subtlety.

#### MISTERIOSO

[mysteriously]

A series of chamber concerts whose programs and often intimate nature of the performances, at times involving only a few musicians, introduce a world of mysterious sonorities and musical dialogue. The events in the series are a great challenge for the performers: their true artistry is reflected in their sonic integrity, creative approach to musical narration and close personal contact with the listener.

#### RUBATO

It is a series presenting traditional and ethnic music in various artistic perspectives. It is a meeting with music from all over the world in such acoustically adapted conditions of philharmonic concert halls that every listener could appreciate the nuances and values of traditional music. The 2020\_2021 season is a presentation of ethnic minorities' music, people living in Poland both in the past and now.

#### SOUNDLAB

Philharmonic laboratory of electronic music in Szczecin with lively communication between the musicians, the listener and the space. The unusual shape of the Szczecin Philharmonic will serve here as a form which will intersect the sound and the architectural shape, thus helping us realise that complementarity is featured in all areas of art. The series formula, which can be called an architectural sound sequence, will allow for the presentation of a wide variety of musical pieces.

#### GRANDIOSO

[splendidly, majestically]

Grand artistic events which will present great symphonic works to celebrate special moments in the artistic season – such as the opening night or the finale of the season. Here events referring to the history of the city are also included. The 2020\_2021 artistic season promises to be exceptional. The situation we all have found ourselves in requires innovative solutions. Apart from the traditional form of participation in live events, we have planned a wide range of online concerts for you. At home, you can move to the Philharmonic concert halls in Szczecin and actively participate in our concerts via the Internet. Modern technology allows us to maintain constant contact with you and disseminate our philharmonics' cultural goods. We hope it will be a time to discover new possibilities for you. We offer the following forms of participation in the concerts:

#### PAID ONLINE CONCERTS

Responding to the needs of the times and wanting to provide all of you with unrestrained and safe participation in the Philharmonic events while maintaining high acoustic and technical values, we are launching the opportunity to participate in concerts for the first time transmitted from the Symphony Hall via the website livefilharmonia. szczecin.pl. Tickets for individual online concerts will also be available here. There will be tickets allowing access to the concert for 24 hours from the premiere or up to 72 hours. Detailed information on ticket prices can be found on pages 51-52. At selected online concerts, the traditional form of participation in concert halls will also be available. Online concerts are marked with a special logo in the season's program. Instructions regarding this form of participation in concerts will be posted on the Philharmonic's news channels. The online sale of tickets for the broadcast concerts is scheduled to start on 01.09.2020.







This year's sixth edition of the True Musicians Tournament will take place on September 3rd-6th but in a changed formula. The Tournament events will be moved to the online zone, on the Philharmonic channels. There, you will be able to watch the concert inaugurating the tournament and take part in folk dance workshops led by Jacek Hałas and white singing workshops

led by Agata Harz. As every year, the creators of traditional music will also compete. This time the jury and the audience will select the winners from among the winners of the previous five editions of the True Musicians Tournament.

This year's competition formula will be an excellent opportunity to recall the previous editions of the tournament. We mean the best singers, instrumentalists, singing groups, and bands that have appeared at the Philharmonic in Szczecin since 2015. The four-day activities will be crowned with the final concert, which will also be available online.

#### The founder of the award for the winner of the 6th edition of the True Musicians Tournament is Jarosław Rzepa, a Member of the Polish Parliament.

# MUSIC.DESIGN.FORM Festival 2020 23-27 września

We fall asleep and wake up, surrounded by sounds. The noise of cars passing outside the window, the barking of a neighbour's dog, the radio playing in the background, office equipment at work, birds singing in the park, phone calls, music in shops and shopping malls, the sound of the forest or the river - all these create a sound landscape that affects our senses and lives.

The third edition of the MUSIC.DESIGN.FORM Festival, which will take place on September 23-27, 2020, is all about SOUNDSCAPES. Three concerts that will be broadcast online will take us to the world of sounds inspired by nature, a journey through the urban jungle, and the endless ocean. The premiere of the newest music project by Hania Rani and Dobrawa Czocher will be heard. As every year, the Szczecin Philharmonic Symphony Orchestra will also perform. It will present a colourful and vivid program. The Echo Collective will constitute a musical culmination of the festival. The ensemble combines classical music with popular music without prejudice and sticking to borders.

We will invite you to search for Szczecin's sounds during a city walk to revive your sense in the evening with a musical set by Agnieszka Obszańska, during which the white lobby of the Philharmonic will turn into a stage full of spectacular visualizations. Directly under the geometric roof of the Philharmonic, in the Level 4. Gallery, we will present the exhibition 'White Balance' by photographer Witek Orski, which will become a counterpoint to the leading soundscapes. The exhibited works will constitute a special documentation of artifacts from the historic Szczecin's 'African Collection'. The way of their exposure and colorful lighting will refer to the white visual balance, showing the ambiguity and discretion of what we used to interpret as white and non-white. During the two-day workshop, we will introduce young people to the world of the city's sounds, which will give birth to a composition performed during an open-air concert. The youngest ones will discover music among objects that seemingly do not play, and then create a map to help find sounds.

There will be a sound installation, which we will be presented online this time. It will be a colorful illumination of the Philharmonic building, with a special setting dedicated to the Music.Design.Form Festival.

We will take you on a sonic journey that will allow you to experience the world through conscious listening and using your senses. We hope that the active reception of the soundscape will raise the sonological qualifications of each of us. Hopefully, it will provoke reflection on the phenomenon of sound, which is often neglected in the image's culture.

The title of the work alludes to the lack of dialogue. The work presents an absurd vision of today's reality, which is influenced by such dominant issues and right-wing populism, climate change, and denial, the so-called "faith versus facts" mentality, and the resulting social divisions.



Level 4. is the culmination of the space, located just under the roof, where we organize exhibitions. This space's extraordinary plasticity creates comprehensive arrangement possibilities that allow the implementation of various forms and interdisciplinary activities. In the 2020\_2021 artistic season, we have planned exhibitions consistent with the programmed

musical repertoire, illustrating the relationship between the world of music and visual arts.

Today, the relations of music in literature, performativity of all branches of art, visual arts influence on music, and vice versa are often emphasized. Contemporary art today fulfils the old dreams of Gesamtkunstwerk, as well as the synesthetic use of various means and disciplines in one work. We will present you with different generations of artists, forms, and fields of art and thematic diversity, showing a broad panorama of today's contemporary art issues in relation to other areas of culture, science, and social phenomena.

## WITEK ORSKI | WHITE BALANCE

#### CURATOR: KAMIL KUSKOWSKI

The project will reflect the landscape of an African village exhibited nearby at the National Museum. The presented photos will be a documentation of items from the historical Szczecin 'African Collection', currently divided between the National Museum in Szczecin and the Ethnographic Museum in Warsaw. The historically formulated universalist, internationalist, and humanistic postulates during the communist period will be confronted with contemporary postcolonial reflection. It forces us to read the collections of African artifacts scattered around Europe as symbols of the white man's absolute cultural domination.

#### VERNISSAGE 23.09.2020

The title concept of white balance used in digital photography will be treated as a metaphor for the deconstruction of 'balance' and 'order' that the colonizers carried out for centuries on African cultures. Simultaneously, the way the photos are displayed and their specially prepared, colored lighting will directly relate to the white visual balance. It will show the ambiguity and discretion of what we used to interpret as white and non-white. It is hard to find a better context for such a project than the white interior landscape of the Philharmonic in Szczecin.

## THE CHATTER OF THE ORBS

#### CURATOR: STANISŁAW RUKSZA

The work of Bartosz Sikorski is the result of close links between music and visual arts. The synesthetic ambitions of visualizing the composition or sounding the image are the source of many attempts by artists to influence the multitude of senses, explaining the work with various media, and finally limiting the composition to pure absolute values, such as sound and timbre. Sikorski's works are the result of recognizing and understanding a similar structure of a sound or visual piece and the way they were created, e.g. the similarity of using a bristle brush while painting on the vertical surfaces of images to the bristle hair extracting a sound from a double bass.

#### VERNISSAGE 26.11.2020

The 'The chatter of the orbs' exhibition will present polyptychs arranged into installations, consisting of images 'supporting the wall' - totems, sound compositions, sound-art installations and video projections with musical connotations, as well as the latest LED images and sound installations.

The opening of the exhibition will be accompanied by a concert by OLOBARTOLO 'SZCZEBIOT ORŁÓW' (Aleksander Gabryś, Bartosz Sikorski and Tomasz Manderla).

The Philharmonic's exhibition activity in the new artistic season 2020\_2021 is carried out in cooperation with Szczecin art centres: the Academy of Arts and TRAFO Trafostacja Sztuki.

## GALLERY BY THE ORTHODOX CHURCH

An inapparent space for artistic meetings. It is located on the third level near the entrance to the balcony of the Symphony Hall. During the concert, it provides comfort to music lovers. It promotes intimate conversations and ascetic concepts. It is regularly filled with graphic and photographic forms.

What can define this gallery are modernity and youth. Artists associated with artistic colleges around the country gather around. As part of a variety of projects, works of people from

around the world are presented in many fields of art, including architecture and music. Some of the events taking place are premieres, with others allowing you to get acquainted with projects that have been shown in other parts of the world.

The golden church dome visible through the window is a permanent counterpoint of this space. A straight path leads from the Orthodox Church to the Level 4. Gallery where the next dimension of artistic works is spread.

## THE SOCIAL CAMPAIGN - 'HEARING GOOD SOUNDS'

Our everyday acoustic landscapes are becoming more and more crowded - at least a third of Poles of all ages live in excessive noise. We usually disregard noise, we agree with it, explain it using civilization reasons. However, it negatively affects our health: first of all, it destroys sensory cells in the inner ear that are not able to renew themselves. Our hearing deteriorates slowly, which affects the overall quality of life. Noise also harms the nervous system, which is manifested by dizziness and headache, tinnitus, sleep disturbance, increased blood pressure, and fatigue. Physical and intellectual activity, ability to concentrate attention, analytical and synthetic reasoning become difficult. This is also the most common cause of attention deficit hyperactivity disorder. The number of hearingimpaired children is increasing so quickly that specialists began to classify hearing loss as a civilization disease!

HEARING GOOD SOUNDS

Not only do we want our music lovers - young and old - to recognize good sounds, but also to fully enjoy them. That is why since 2016 the Mieczysław Karłowicz Philharmonic in Szczecin, together with local and national partners, has been implementing the social campaign Hearing Good Sounds (in Polish: Słyszę Dobre Dźwięki). It encompasses actions at the micro and macro scale, whose aim is to make a wide audience realize that our lives do not have to have a very loud soundtrack. Through workshops, meetings and educational games for children, adolescents and adults, industry conferences, events in the urban space, non-standard artistic events or a billboard campaign, Hearing Good Sounds encourages to fight noise and take care of the most sensitive audio equipment we have: our ears. We also inspire recipients to search for unique places to escape from the noise, i.e. school and urban harmony zones that are created in schools throughout the region and the urban space of Szczecin. We engage dozens of volunteers and partners in our activities, who - like us - believe that protection and care for hearing constitutes a concern for the quality of life.






